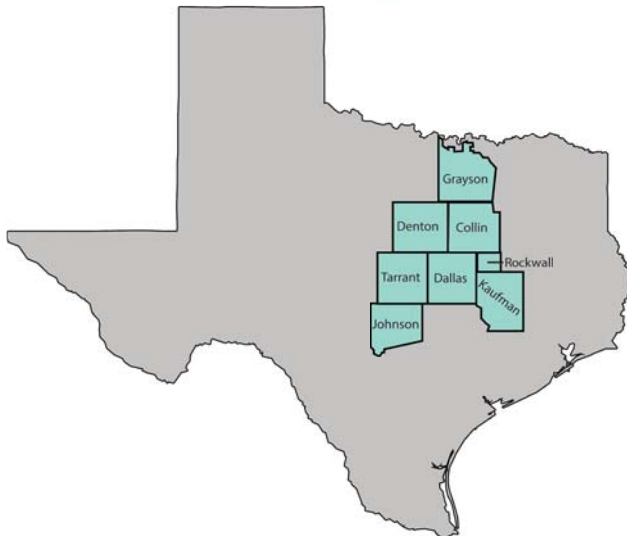

## Frequently Asked Questions

### *What is Home Health?*

Home health is a service that you receive in your home setting when you need intermittent skilled care by a clinical staff member in order to treat an acute or chronic illness because it is too difficult for you to leave your home in order to receive comparable services.

The goal of home health services is to help you regain your independence and promote activities that improve your quality of life. When you receive home health, you will be assessed for the following disciplines: Nursing, Therapist (Physical, Occupational, and/or Speech), Home Health Aide, and Social Work.

### *Do I Qualify for Home Health?*

We will need to obtain authorization from your physician stating that you need home health services. You must have a need for intermittent skilled care at home. In addition, you will need to be considered "homebound" which means that it is difficult for you to leave your home without it being a taxing effort for you.

## Specialty Programs

### **Hospital to Home Bridge Program**

Bridging hospital core measures and disease management to the home setting. Goal is to provide seamless continuum of care and avoid unnecessary re-hospitalization.

### **Cardiac Management**

Provide comprehensive approach to managing cardiac related diagnoses with collaboration of multidisciplinary team.

### **Respiratory Management**

Provide individualized treatment, rehab, and education at all stages of the disease in order to promote higher quality of life.

### **Rehabilitation Program**

Patients receive individualized treatment plans designed to encourage maximum recovery and independence under the guidelines of home health.

### **Oncology Program**

Skilled and compassionate clinical attention to an individual's cancer treatment plan. Expertise in pain management. Multidisciplinary team will work in collaboration with the oncology team in order to ensure the best plan of action.

### **Transplant Program**

Strict collaboration with Transplant Center in treating and managing pre and post transplant patients. Understand symptoms and treatment throughout pre and post transplant course. Provide continual education.

### **Intravenous (IV) Infusion**

Taking care of a patient with an IV need involves teaching and demonstration. Goal is for the patient to foster independence. Provide continual education on ways to keep the IV operating safely and effectively for the duration of the medication.

### **Enteral Management**

Educate and reinforce teaching to the patient and family on disease care and management. Will be a key advocator in patient mastering their specific GI needs.

### **Wound Care Management**

Intense collaboration with wound care physician to improve wound care healing. Continuous education with patient and family on measures needed in order for the healing process to be successful.

### **Urological Program**

Provide urological services where management and prevention are the focus. Education on healthy living tips for patients who have urology care needs. Provide education on techniques to improve quality of life.

### **Palliative Care Program**

Provides comfort measures along with life-prolonging treatment with the use of medical care plan following shared goals, values and priorities.

### **Orthopedic Care**

For patients recovering from orthopedic surgery, we provide home health care designed to improve mobility and function and return you to a more active life
